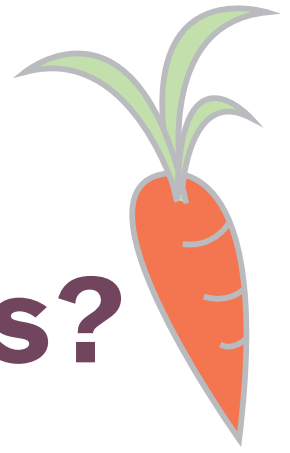


# What does FOW expect from our Foster Care Providers?

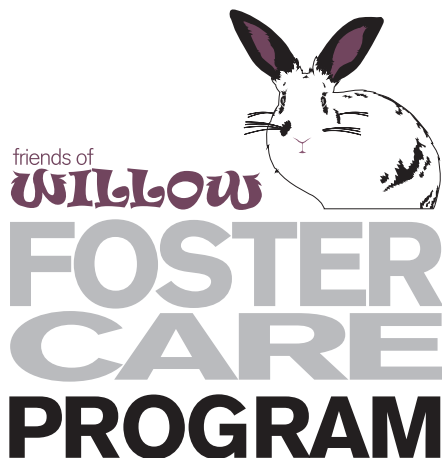


## Simple, we'll tell you!

- **No Experience Required!** A Friends of Willow (FOW) Foster Care Provider should understand that previous fostering experience is NOT required, and that FOW will provide you with all the knowledge you need to successfully foster a rabbit.
- **It's only a 6-month term!** A FOW Foster Care Provider should understand that FOW has strict time limits set for how long each rabbit can stay under a foster providers care. These limits are set for the benefit of our foster providers. We recognize that foster care is temporary, and we value you as a priceless asset to FOW that won't be exploited. Except in emergency situations, a foster term should not be broken, for the sake of our resources and each rabbits' well-being.
- **You're directly helping homeless rabbits!** A FOW Foster Care Provider should be committed to aiding Friends of Willow in finding their foster rabbit a safe and loving "forever home", including providing transport to vet care and/or Meet & Greets when possible.
- **Your TLC is needed!** A FOW Foster Care Provider should provide each rabbit with good and loving care, including but not limited to; food, water, shelter, grooming and medical attention when required. (Friends of Willow will reimburse the cost of any approved medical care or unapproved medical care that is sought in an emergency situation)
- **A great Learning Opportunity!** A FOW Foster Care Provider should comply with all local and state laws and ordinances relating to the care of domestic animals, and will not engage in any illegal activity with a foster rabbit.
- **Be a Caretaking Hero!** A FOW Foster Care Provider should understand that no foster rabbit is allowed outside if unattended and/or unrestrained.
- **A great Teaching Opportunity!** A FOW Foster Care Provider should understand that no foster rabbit is allowed to be left unattended with children or other pets.
- **Improve your Skills!** A FOW Foster Care Provider should use only positive reinforcement for training and will NOT use any kind of physical punishment under any circumstances.

### Friends of Willow shall provide the following to each Foster Care Provider during their foster term, if needed:

- Your first bag of food, your first bag of hay, toy(s), cage/x-pen with ample room and approved medical care! After these initial supplies are exhausted, FOW will provide you with cost-effective solutions to provide for your foster rabbit. We do require that all supplies owned by FOW are returned when your foster term is up.
